There have been 15 State and 2 Federal indictments/charges in Kentucky on human trafficking. There has been I successful federal prosecution on a sex trafficking charge. Several state and federal prosecutions are ongoing. At least 6 additional human trafficking cases have been charged, but the prosecution is on charges other than human trafficking.
